



Reading in the summer vacation

Soon it will be summer vacation again! Time for sun, being free and... reading a good book? Unfortunately, the latter is not all too obvious. That is a shame, because children who hardly read during the summer holidays run the risk of falling back as much as 1 or 2 AVI levels in their reading development. That is why reading during the summer vacation is super important.

Reading during the summer vacation has been made extra easy! Children can borrow books from the library at school for longer and they can use the 'Online Bibliotheek' app for free!

Borrow books from the library at school for an extra-long time

In the library at school, children can borrow books from Monday 5 July until **Monday 13 September**. After the holidays there is still some time to collect the books and return them at school. The children can also borrow **6 books at the same time** until 13 September. So that will be a nice long read during the holidays!

See what has been borrowed?

With the pass number of the library at school-pass you can log in to "My Library" on the library website. There you can see what has been borrowed and when it must be returned. The books can be extended and an e-mail address can be provided. A reminder will be sent to this e-mail address when the books are about to be returned or renewed

The online Library-app

You can also read digitally during the summer holidays! Children can continue reading in the online Library app with a free youth subscription or their school library pass in the summer. The app is free!

Tip

Write down the pass number of your child's library card at school! Then you can always log in to "My Library" via the website: www.bibliotheekeindhoven.nl

Logging in on "My Library"

You log in with the card number (starting with 4050...) and a four-digit combination of your child's date of birth. The month of birth and the last two digits of the year of birth. Example: date of birth 8 June 2009 becomes 0609.

Important dates:

- **From Monday 5 July:** Borrow books for an extra-long time, until 13 September
- **From Monday 5 July:** Borrow a max. of 6 books at the same time
- **No later than Monday 13 September:** Return the borrowed holiday books
